SUPPLIES

COURSE DESCRIPTION

I hope you had a fantastic summer and are ready for a successful new school year! This course builds on seventh grade math curriculum and will provide you with all of the building blocks to prepare you for your first high school math course, Algebra 1. We will also work on strengthening your work habits so you can be as ready as possible for a smooth year of math, this year and in the future.

Instructional time will focus on three critical areas:

- Formulating and reasoning with expressions and equations, including modeling associations with linear equations, and solving linear equations and systems of linear equations.
- Grasping the concept of a function and using functions to describe relationships.
- Analyzing 2- and 3-dimensional space and figures.

TESTS (55%):

Approximately two unit tests will be given each marking period on a given unit of study. Tests will include multiple choice, short response & extended response questions.

QUIZZES (35%):

Quizzes can be given at anytime on material covered. They may or may not be announced. These are intended to check for understanding within a specific topic in a unit.

HOMEWORK (10%):

Homework will be assigned regularly. All questions must be attempted with all work shown to receive full credit. No credit will be given for simply stating answers. Late homework will NOT be accepted, except for in the case of excused absences.
